

2011 ACBA Junior Open - Rules of Play

1. Entries must be accompanied by the full payment of entry fees and must reach the Tournament Organisers on or before Mon 17/10/2011. **Please make all cheques and money orders out to ACBA. Direct deposit to ANZ Bank BSB 012 266 Account no. 183 060 515. (Please insert your name as reference for easy tracing).**
2. Appropriate badminton attire must be worn when on court. Non-marking shoes must be worn at all times in the hall. **If anyone is found with shoes that mark, they will risk disqualification.**
3. Events will be conducted in knockout or round robin format depending on the number of entries.
4. Each player must submit a separate entry form including the fees for that player.
5. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel any event if insufficient entries are received. Players' co-operation to be on time for their matches is appreciated. **Players who fail to turn up and/or proceed to the courts within a 10 mins grace-period of their names being called may face a forfeit of the games and will not be entitled to any refunds.**
6. There is a two-minute warm up time. Umpires must make sure players start the game once this time is over. Courts are available for the specified time ONLY. All players must be at the Hall at least 15 minutes early.
7. The Tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by the Badminton World Federation (B.W.F.) for the carrying out of Tournaments except as altered by these conditions.
8. Players may be required to umpire and line judge some matches.
9. The player's age must be under the age category as of Dec 2011. (i.e.U13 player must be born in 1999 or later)
10. Start times may be varied and should be confirmed with the organisers the day before the tournament.
11. Prize money is available for U17 and U19 events that have a minimum of 8 entries.
